1. Call to order

Meeting called to order at 7:07

- 2. Approval of agenda, review and/or revision Agenda approved as presented.
- 3. Rounds and mail (SPC members' updates and review PC mail received).

Melissa described the Forest Block and Wildlife Connectivity webinar that she attended showing Biofinder wildlife layers including Forest Blocks and Riparian Connectivity. The second part showed the Community Value mapping that Fish and Wildlife is helping towns conduct. The values mapped include wildlife, forests, recreation, scenic, historic and economic features.

Laura described the Rutland Regional Planning Commission meeting; there is money for South Lake Champlain Clean Watershed Project, Rutland Regional will be doing a new Regional Plan next year, Mendon is working on an enhanced energy plan, Poultney is working on a Town Plan and an Enhanced energy plan.

Laura heard back from Adrienne Raymond on short-term vacation type rentals, she suggested registration of these places with the Selectboard as a way to start. We do not know how many short-term rentals there are in Shrewsbury. The concern is if local people are being priced out of the rentals market by vacation rentals.

- 4. Acceptance of meeting minutes of November 9, 2021. Meeting minutes were accepted as written.
- 5. Flood Hazard Regs information from Rutland Regional Planning Commission Laura contacted Barbara Noyes Pulling about our questions. The number 5 item (Improvement to Existing Structures That Decrease Pre-Existing Distance to Waterway) is only in the WRC version. Maybe we should delete it from the table. There is a diagram for the River Corridor in our definitions that is outdated. The ANR model has a different diagram – Melissa will replace the one in the Draft Flood Hazard Bylaw. Laura asked if we should send the draft to Adrienne Raymond, the DRB and the Selectboard for an initial review. Laura will write a cover letter with the reasons that the River Corridor Bylaw is important.
