

**Minutes of Selectboard Meeting
September 2nd, 2026**

Present at meeting: *Selectboard Members:* Aaron Korzun, Marc Cimonetti, Francis Wyatt. *Town Clerk:* Rebecca Rice. *Admin Assistant:* Alaina Cimonetti (Remotely).

Active Participants: Kevin Winters *State House Representative*. Sue Brown *Member of the Public*.

The meeting was convened at 6:36 PM.

Agenda: Motion made by A. Korzun to follow the agenda with no additions. Seconded by F. Wyatt. All in favor, motion approved.

Road Projects Update: Paving is complete on the main area of Lincoln Hill Road. The triangle at the center will be paved soon. The road crew has been working on other culverts on Spring Lake Road as well as road improvements on Upper Cold River Road. TH2 the Culvert project just south of Mountain School Road has been completed as well as the emergency culvert repair on Eastham Road (near Mt Holly Road).

Liquor License: A. Korzun made a motion to approve the outside consumption permit for Pierce's Store. Seconded by F. Wyatt. Approved.

New Business / Open to the Public: Sue Brown and her husband kindly try to pick up garbage around the Brown Bridge as often as they can. Recently they found a large amount of trash thrown over the bank near the bridge. They also found a discarded mattress, windows and other trash in the Brown Bridge Parking Lot. She is hoping as a town we can find a way to prevent this from happening. Town employees have looked through garbage in the past looking for identifying information as well as set up a deer camera in an attempt to identify those who are littering, those efforts have been unsuccessful to date.

Kevin Winter our State House Reprehensive attended the meeting. He has offered his time to help the Selectboard in any way he can and encourages the board to reach out to him if they have questions or ideas that could improve our ability to accomplish projects needed in the town

Tyler Technologies is starting the reappraisal process. The Board wants to make sure that residents know to make an appointment through the QR code or call Mimi Burstein (Contract Assessor) to make an appointment. The Selectboard would like to make it clear that residents have the to right to have Tyler Technologies enter their home and evaluate and we encourage residents to do so. The homeowner also has the right to refuse entry. Residents who have had their homes evaluated have reported the process is very simple.

Review Orders: M. Cimonetti made a motion to approve the Selectboard Orders #9 for a total of \$5,066.11 and Road Orders #9 for a total of \$48,796.22. Seconded by F. Wyatt. Approved.
